Description

This affordable and reliable product is an easy repair solution for all pot holes, making good trenches, weed and root damage repair and fractured edging. It is compatible with existing road surfaces and features many advantages, such as the fact it can be applied in all weathers, including rain and it is instantly trafficable. In addition, it offers high skid resistance due to the specially formulated bitumen and interlocking aggregate.

Directions for use:

PERMANENT POT HOLE REPAIRER can be applied at depths between 20mm - 100mm (0.7 - 3.9 inches). Greater depths can be achieved by applying the layer-on-layer method.

Application:

- Chip away fractured tarmac from around the edges until the surface is sound. Ensure the pothole is free from debris and standing water.
- To ensure the best possible durability to your repair, it is recommended that the edges of the existing surfaces be sealed with SkilledBuild Bitumen Cold Joint Sealer.
- Fill the pothole with pothole repair product straight from the tub. It is recommended that when applying over a concrete or smooth base or to obtain best adhesion, the base of the hole should be primed with SkilledBuild Tack Adhesive or use SkilledBuild Bitumen Cold Joint Sealer for small areas.
- Apply product slightly higher than the pothole. Tamp down to fully compress the repair and achieve the desired finish height. Use a SkilledBuild Tarmac Tamper or similar. Small areas may be successfully compressed using a lump hammer and a hardwood pad.
- Repairs exceeding 40mm in depth should be built-up in layers not exceeding 40mm, with each layer being consecutively tamped and compressed prior to the next layer being applied.
- Tamp down to compact the material to complete the application. If initial section being tamped is too high or lower than the surrounding surface, then add or remove a layer of the uncompressed repair product so that the compacted area will finish as required.
