# Areas of Use

## Description

A concentrated microemulsion insecticide based on low toxicity contact insecticide Permethrin. It is designed to prevent and eradicate Common Furniture Beetle (Anobium punctatum) and other wood destroying insects.

# **Directions for use:**

### **Preparation:**

- Ensure all timber surfaces are adequately exposed and clean (vacuuming preferred) and free from previously applied paint coatings, varnishes etc. and are in a condition which allows the treatment to penetrate successfully.
- Where there are signs of previous infestation, a full structural assessment may be necessary to determine any timbers that may be so badly decayed that they require replacement before treatment begins.
- All bats are protected under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. Before treating any structure used by bats, consult Natural England, Scottish Natural Heritage or the Countryside Council for Wales.

### **Application:**

- The product is supplied as a concentrate to be diluted with water by adding 1 litre of Woodworm Killer to 24 litres of water to yield 25 litres of ready to use Woodworm Killer.
- Once made, please ensure that drums of the ready to use product are suitably labelled during use and storage.
- Where applicable, notify occupants of adjoining properties before treatment commences.
- Apply the diluted product by either brush or low pressure spray giving a course droplet (low pressure: 210-350kPa, 30-50 lbs/in2).
- The timber should be saturated to refusal, paying particular attention to areas confirming insect emergence (i.e. small holes). Exposed end grains, reverse of stair boards and sub floor joists must be exposed to allow sufficient access for adequate effective treatment.



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# Safety:

- Irritating to eyes. May cause sensitisation by skin contact.

- WEAR SUITABLE PROTECTIVE CLOTHING (COVERALLS) AND SYNTHETIC RUBBER/PVC GLOVES when using, plus FACE PROTECTION when diluting. DO NOT BREATHE SPRAY MIST. Otherwise wear respiratory protective equipment and eye protection (see HSE Guidance Booklet HS (G): 'Respiratory Protective Equipment – a practical guide for users').
- AVOID EXCESSIVE CONTAMINATION OF COVERALLS AND LAUNDER REGULARLY. However engineering controls may replace personal protective equipment if a COSHH assessment shows they provide an equal or higher standard of protection.
- DO NOT CONTAMINATE FOODSTUFFS, EATING UTENSILS OR FOOD CONTACT SURFACES. This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way. Wear suitable eye/face protection (when diluting). BEFORE TREATING ANY STRUCTURE USED BY BATS, CONSULT NATURAL ENGLAND, SCOTTISH NATURAL HERITAGE OR THE COUNTRYSIDE COUNCIL FOR WALES. COVER WATER STORAGE TANKS BEFORE APPLICATION. FOR INDOOR USE ONLY. REMOVE OR COVER ALL FISH TANKS AND BOWLS BEFORE APPLICATION. Do not contaminate ground, waterbodies or watercourses with chemicals or used containers.

### Product Data

**Storage:** The product should be stored in a cool dry place.

### **Coverage:**

- Coarse Spray: 1litre to 3-4m<sup>2</sup>.
- 1 litre pack diluted to 25 litres with water covers a maximum of 100m<sup>2</sup>.
- 4 x 1 litre packs treats the roof void of a typical 3 bedroom semi-detached house.
